Morning Arrival Time

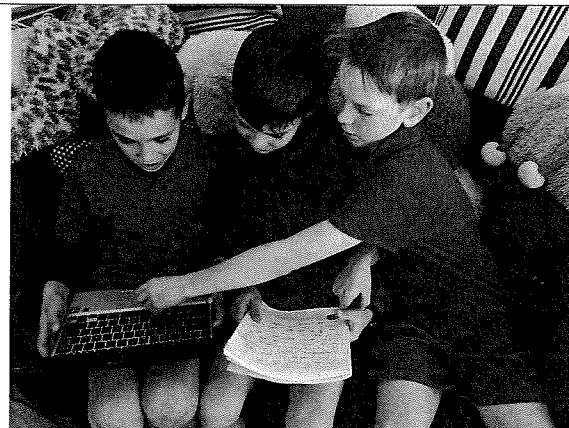

My Monster

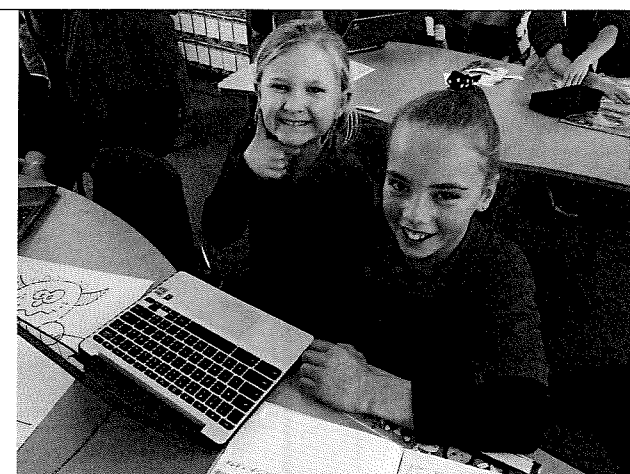

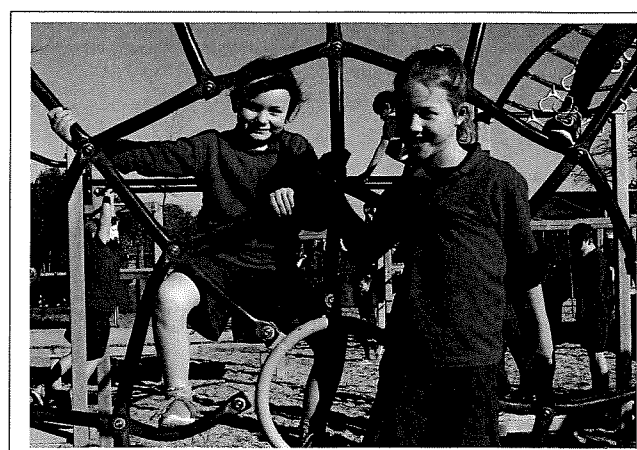
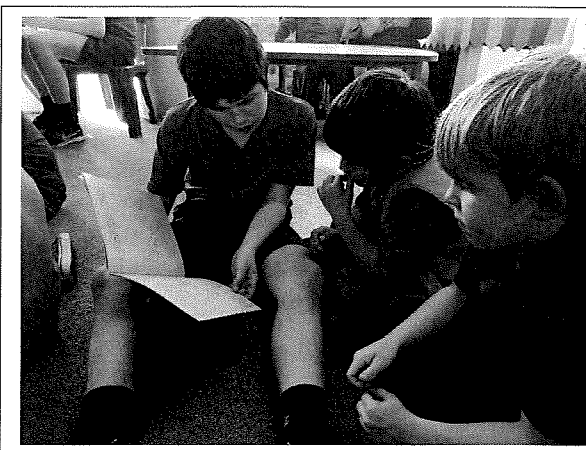
My Monster
